The next issue of *democracy* will focus on the theme of religion and democracy. Among the planned articles are: Julius Lester on morality and education; Christopher Hill on religion and radicalism; Sheldon S. Wolin on civil religion; and Joe Holland on the radicalization of the Catholic Church.

Also in the April issue: Jean Bethke Elshtain on feminism and the state; and Herbert Gans on democratic culture.

Future issues will contain articles by Harry C. Boyte on citizen action, Ignacy Sachs on development and maldevelopment, Ken Coates on the European Nuclear Disarmament (END) campaign, and John Schaar on Jacques Ellul. There will be reviews of Alasdair MacIntyre's *After Virtue* by Hanna Pitkin, and James Fallows's *National Defense* by Wilson Carey McWilliams.

The editors of *democracy* welcome proposals for articles. Future themes will include: participation, pluralism, and corporatism; democracy and technology; education and democracy; and separate issues on agrarian and urban prospects for democracy.
